Dr T K Bhat General Secretary ASKPC in his address, alleged that these ex-Chief Ministers and Ministers just want to enjoy power and at the same time keep separatists' politics alive in Valley besides using the same to blackmail New Delhi for their vested interests as everybody knows that their previous governments could not address so-called Kashmir problem through employment, development and economic measures, so what is urgency for early polls. Among others present on the occasion included R K Wangnoo Senior Vice President, Veena Gurtoo Women Wing President, Bharat Bushan Gosain Ex-General Secretary, B L Handoo and S K Raina.

## Shiv Sena demands security cover for leaders before elections

JAMMU: Expressing grave concern on apathetic attitude of the Government towards security of Shiv Sena leaders, President, Dimpy Kohli and General Secretary, Manish Sahni on Thursday demanded adequate security cover for its leaders well before the general elections. While interacting with media persons, President Dimpy Kohli and General Secretary Manish Sahni said that the top brass of the

party is very much concerned regarding the security issues of party leaders in Jammu & Kashmir. Kohli said they have taken up the issue with administration numerous times in past but nothing has been done in this regard. "It seems that same is being done deliberately to keep Sena out of fray in Jammu and Kashmir," he alleged. Kohli further said that in 2018, Shiv Sena MPs have also written to the Home Minister for providing security to party leaders of

Jammu & Kashmir, but no action was initiated in this regard. Kohli further informed that he had received numerous threatening letters written in Urdu several times. It is pertinent to remember after hoisting the National flag in December 2017 at Lal Chowk Srinagar, stones were pelted at State General Secretary, Manish Sahni's residence and Pakistani flag also was thrown, against which a FIR was registered at concerned Police Station. The party high command has made it clear that they would allow leaders to participate in elections in J&K only if adequate security cover would be provided to them, they informed. ## RBI holds workshop for specialised MSME bank branches

JAMMU: RBI Jammu on Thursday organised 12th workshop of National Mission for Capacity Building of Bankers for Financing MSME sector (NAMCABS) here. The workshop was inaugurated by Thomas Mathew, Regional Director for Jammu and Kashmir (J&K) RBI, in which 36 bank officials, working in the State participated. In his inaugural address, Thomas Mathew highlighted the importance of MSME sector, their contribution in GDP, country's exports, providers of employment and the important role to be played by banks. He impressed upon the need of concerted efforts and commitment from banking community for development of MSME sector. He appealed to the bank officials to enhance lending to MSMEs in the State and be more sensitive towards the needs of small entrepreneurs.

Satya Narain, General Manager, RBI welcomed all the participants and reiterated the significance of conducting the workshop. He informed that the broad objectives of NAMCABS are to build skills for MSME lending and develop entrepreneurial sensitivity among field-level functionaries of specialised MSME branches of commercial banks and the mission is to train officials of banks in J&K State, dealing with MSME lending. The training sessions focused on functional aspects, including RBI and Government directions/guidelines to banks relating

to MSME sector, schemes related to MSME sector, credit appraisal and NPA management techniques, Trade Receivables and Discounting System (TReDS) and movable financing, FinTech and disruption in banking sector, etc, as well as soft aspects of lending such as entrepreneurial sensitivity, emotional intelligence, communication skills etc, required to handle the first-generation entrepreneurs as well as existing MSME borrowers. Experts from RBI, Quality Council of India, SIDBI and J&K Bank conducted the sessions.

## Bee Enn Hospital observes World Kidney Day

## Mehbooba Mufti betrayed Constitution, worked against national interest: BJP

JAMMU: BJP State Spokesperson, Brig Anil Gupta on Thursday said that the former Chief Minister, Mehbooba Mufti has time and again confessed her role in promoting pro-Pakistan separatists' agenda while she was occupying the esteemed chair of the State's Chief Minister and betrayed the oath of loyalty and secrecy she had taken at the time, she was sworn in as the CM. In a statement issued here on Thursday, Brig Anil Gupta, State Spokesperson said, "While in Jammu, she was busy playing divisive and communal politics by attempting to break centuries-old brotherhood, bonding and bonhomie between Gujjars and Dogras, while in Kashmir she was relentlessly working for Jamat-e-Islami Kashmir (JeIK) and pursuing agenda laid down by Hurriyat. It was for this reason that she held the Home portfolio herself and did not even have a MOS despite the State being infested with terrorism." "JeIK ever since its inception has been promoting a pro-Pak agenda and questioning State's accession with India. It is also responsible for encouraging separatism and terrorism with Hizbul Mujahidin (HM), JeIK

is a fascist-religious organisation which proudly proclaimed 'Azadi Barai Islam' (Freedom for Azadi) as its motto on its website. Mehbooba has herself confessed that she did not act against JeIK leaders despite instructions from Centre based on intelligence inputs about their involvement in anti-national activities. While she was wearing the mask of a nationalist and occupied the highest chair in government, she actually was betraying the nation by carrying out anti-national activities and compromising national interests," alleged Brig Gupta. Brig Gupta demanded that a thorough investigation should be held of her role as a CM and the harm, she has done to the nation and based on the findings of the investigation, she should be tried for treason. "If a leader like late Sheikh Mohammad Abdullah can be tried for treason, what prevents a similar action against Mehbooba Mufti when she herself has confessed that she obstructed the Central Government from acting against Hurriyat and JeIK," questioned Brig Gupta. As far as her repeated statements boasting of preventing

BJP government at centre from acting against Hurriyat and Jammat, besides forcing the release of first time stone-pelters and cessation of military operations during Ramzan, Brig Gupta said that it was a clear-cut case of betrayal of faith imposed in her

by the Central government as the Chief Minister of the State. "When it became obvious that she was playing a double-game, no time was lost to disgrace her by withdrawing from the coalition. Most of her senior party colleagues were also surprised by her dual face and deserted

her soon thereafter," claimed Brig Gupta. Mehbooba's role in the assassination of Journalist Sujaat Bukhari also needs to be investigated as he reportedly met her a couple of days earlier and apprised her of the threat to his life, asserted Brig Gupta.
